COVID-19 Pandemic Update

- As a reminder, the data collected in the Confirmed Cases by Community Chart is self-reported from communities themselves. The communities are informed by their local Public Health Units. Where possible, the Regional Chief or the Initiatives team follows up with Chiefs in community to confirm case numbers.
- This information comes from a different source than the COO Health Sector and should not be confused with the information the Health Sector provides.

### **CONFIRMED CASES BY COMMUNITY**

- There have been 149 cases in the second wave, thus far, compared to just 66 cases in the first wave. While this is cause for concern, it should be noted that First Nations have always stamped out the virus when it has reached their communities.
- During the second wave, our cases have increased by 226%.
- The Southwest region has experienced the most cases of COVID-19.
- The current total resolve rate is 93%.
- Currently there are 12 active COVID-19 cases within First Nations communities, which is a decrease of 3 from last week.
- A total of 9 communities had active cases this week (an increase of 3 from last week):
  - Six Nations
  - Akwesasne
  - Walpole Island
  - Shoal Lake 40
  - Delaware Nation at Moraviantown
  - Deer Lake
  - Niisaachewan
  - Fort William
  - North Caribou Lake
    - The positive case in this community was not a First Nation member, but an external construction worker who is isolating in the community at this time.
