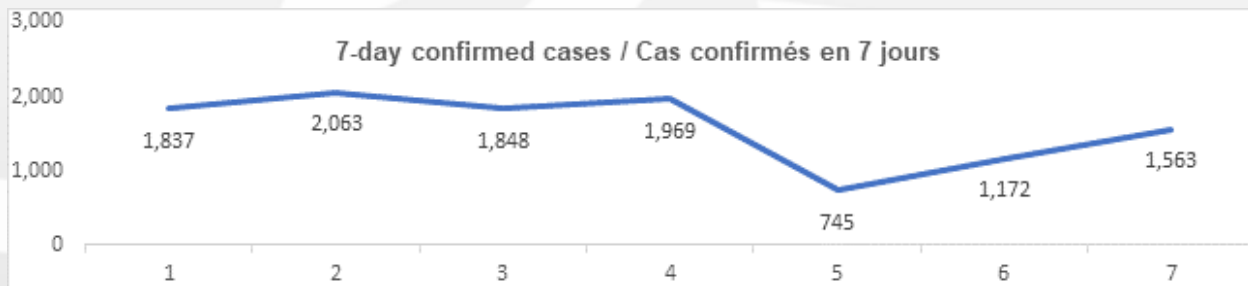

COVID-19 Pandemic Update

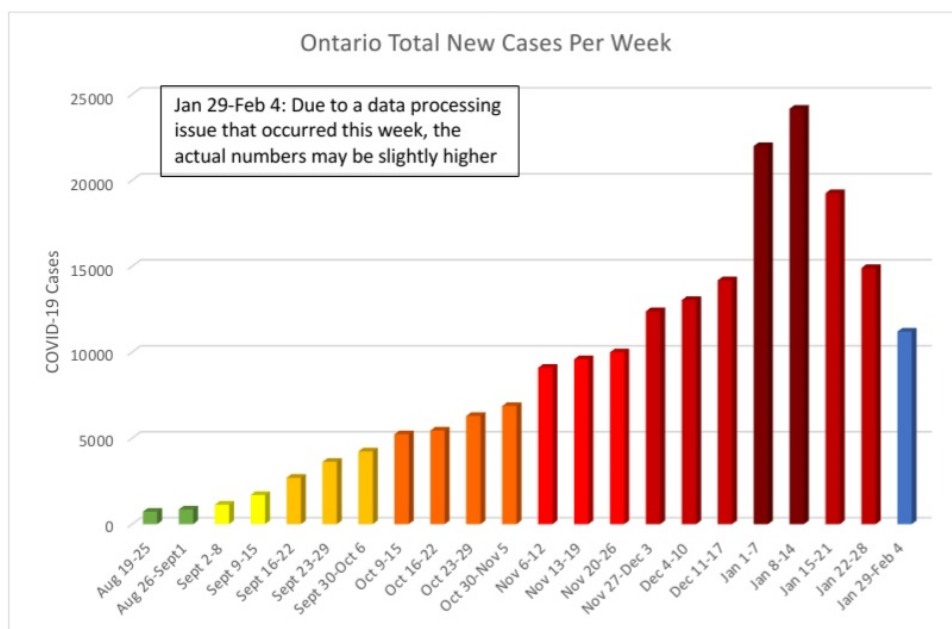
NEW CASES BY DAY

- This week, the case numbers reported may be an underestimation. This is due to a data migration from the Toronto Public Health Unit as they transfer their data to the provincial data system.
- If there are any unaccounted cases from this week, they will likely be added next week.
- Cases ranged between 700 and 2000 daily.



ONTARIO NEW CASES TOTAL

- A total of 11,197 cases were reported in Ontario this week.
 - Even with the underestimation of numbers this week, the total is still over 3000 less than last week.
