COVID-19 Pandemic Update

Please note that starting this week we have changed our reporting of First Nation cases. As we move into the second wave, we have separated the information into two separate charts, one for each wave of the COVID-19 pandemic. This will highlight the similarities and differences between the first and second wave.

SUMMARY OF FIRST NATION CASES IN ONTARIO:

FIRST NATION CASES:

- There are currently 14 confirmed and 9 probable cases in First Nations for a total of 23 active cases. All active cases are currently in Six Nations.
- All other First Nations community cases have been resolved: Rainy River, Washagamis Bay, Moose Factory and Sandy Lake.
