ACTIVE CASES ACROSS ONTARIO

For a fourth week in a row, there has been an increase in cases in Ontario. For the last few weeks, the cases were slowly rising with about a hundred more cases each week, this week there was a jump in cases from 859 to 1131. This is the second week with more than 100 cases reported every day. There are four Public Health Units that are contributing most of the cases these include: Ottawa, Toronto, Peel and York.

Case Decreases:

PHUs that have gone from the orange zone (1-9 active cases) to the green zone (zero cases) include:

- Algoma went from 1 case to 0 cases.
- Sudbury & District went from 1 case to 0 cases.
- Northwestern went from 2 cases to 0 cases.
- Kingston, Frontenac and Lennox & Addington went from 3 cases to 0 cases.
- Southwestern went from 10 cases to 0 cases.
- Huron Perth went from 31 to 0 cases.

PHUs that have gone from the pink zone (10-99 active cases) to the orange zone (1-9 active cases) include:

- Eastern went from 10 cases to 9 cases.
- Middlesex London went from 12 cases to 8 cases.
- Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph went from 14 to 8 cases.

PHUs that have seen a decrease in cases this week include:

- Leeds, Grenville and Lanark went from 9 cases to 2 cases.
- Windsor-Essex went from 77 to 59 cases.

Case Increases:

PHUs that have gone from the pink zone (10-99 active cases) to the red zone (100+ active cases) include:

• York went from 93 cases to 130 cases.

PHUs that have seen a rise in cases include:

- Halton went from 21 to 31 cases.
- Hamilton went from 25 to 47 cases.
- Ottawa went from 214 cases to 225 cases.
- Toronto went from 320 to 439 cases.
- Peel went from 290 to 451 cases.
