SUMMARY OF FIRST NATION CASES IN ONTARIO

There were no new cases reported in First Nation this week!
There is one previously reported case that is still active.
As of today, our recovery/resolved rate is 93%.
176 total cases (65 on-reserve)
2 deaths
62 resolved
20,134 tests conducted since Jan 15
1128 tests done between August 9 – August 15

FIRST NATION CASES:

There were no new cases reported on and off reserve this week. This hasn't happened since the beginning of the pandemic. There is currently one active case in Walpole Island.

***Retesting of all residents in Wiikwemkoong Nursing Home returned as all negative. Ogimaa Duke Peltier explained in an update that the 1 positive will remain in place according to Public Health guidelines.

ACTIVE CASES ACROSS ONTARIO

We have seen a slight increase in cases across Ontario this week, going from 575 cases last week to 683 this week. All Public Health Units (PHU) continue to have less than 200 cases, which is excellent. There are only two PHUs that currently have more than 100 cases.

Case Decreases:

PHUs that have gone from the orange zone (1-9 cases) to the green zone (0 cases) include:

- Porcupine has moved back to the green zone and have no active cases

PHUs that have gone from the red zone (100+ cases) to the pink (10-99 cases) include:

- Windsor Essex went from 120 to 96 cases and has moved to the pink zone

- Ottawa went from 140 cases to 98 cases and has moved to the pink zone

PHUs that have seen a decrease in cases this week include:

- Southwestern went from 64 to 35 cases
- Chatham Kent went from 74 to 50 cases

Case Increases:

PHUs that have gone from the green zone (0 cases) to the orange zone (1-9 cases) include:

- Hastings and Prince Edward went from 0 to 2 cases

PHUs that have gone from the orange zone (1-9 cases) to the pink zone (10-99 cases) include:

- Huron Perth went from 9 to 10 cases
- Lambton went from 9 to 11 cases
- Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph went from 8 to 14 cases

PHUs that have seen a rise in cases include:

- Middlesex-London went from 14 to 26 cases
- Waterloo went from 15 to 30 cases
- Hamilton went from 25 to 49 cases
- Peel went from 126 to 186 cases
- Toronto went from 167 to 197 cases
